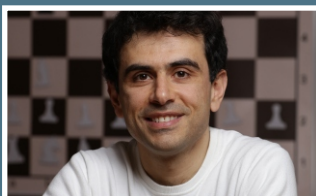
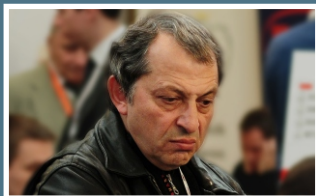

- 1998-2001: Vice President of Ukrainian Chess Federation
- 1977: Soviet youth champion
- 1977, 1980: World youth team champion

## GM Viacheslav Eingorn

- trainer experience since 1979
- 2005-2010: trainer and captain of the Ukrainian women's national team

## GM Arshak Petrosyan

- 1974, 1976: champion of Armenia
- Armenian national team coach – 3 times Olympic champion

## GM Gabriel Sargissian

- member of the gold-medal winning Armenian team at the Chess Olympiads in 2006, 2008 and 2012 and at the World Team Chess Championship in 2011
